

Upon completion, leaders can see clearly where they are now and where they need to go to reach full potential leadership.

Under the guidance of skilled coaches, leaders will be challenged and empowered to develop a framework for creating a culture of trust and building a happier, more loyal, and more productive team.

The program takes place at The Retreat on Charleston Peak, a "nothing fancy" rustic lodge elevated 6,700 ft in the Kyle Canyon located 45 minutes away from the Las Vegas airport.

You'll start to get to know your circle and your instructors as we review The Leader Circle curriculum and our unique approach to field leadership development.
